

A new IT-system should optimize the processes regarding management of logistics of medicaments to the Danish pharmacies at hospitals

After a year and a half preliminary work has Amgros the 15th of June entered a contract with NNIT regarding delivery of a new concerted IT-system, which can manage logistics regarding purchase and distribution of medicaments to the Danish hospital pharmacies and public hospitals.

The new system is going to replace 10 decentralized systems and thereby give approximately 1500 users at the hospital pharmacies a homogeneous and modern IT-solution.

The APOTO-project should lead the way for further efficiency improvement and harmonizing of working procedures of purchasing and distribution of medicaments to hospitals and also taking technological resources in use in order to support working procedures.

Other than handling purchase and distribution, the system is also going to be integrated with the hospitals EJP systems (modules of medicaments) and provide these with master data of medicaments.

The system is based on SAP-software and hence a standard system, which ease maintenance and development of the solution in the years to come.

The work of implementing the SAP-system so it completely matches the hospital pharmacies specific needs and working procedures is in progress. The implementation of the system will happen according to regions, where the first implementation is expected mid 2012.
